Comments

Whilst the Council fully appreciate the desire to safeguard existing employment and, indeed, potentially create further employment opportunities the concern with this application revolves around "Access to the site is un-changed, served by the existing private track that links to the adopted highway between Poltimore and the B3181".

Although not stated in the attached documentation the Council think it reasonable to expect increased storage and economic growth to result in additional vehicular access, unfortunately probably further HGV traffic which would result in further damage to the fabric of the adopted road between Poltimore and the B3181. Many of the vehicles using the Westexe site are too large for the road connecting Poltimore to the B3181 and for much of its length the carriageway is too narrow for such an HGV and a saloon car to pass each other. This would also be accompanied by the mistaken access to Poltimore itself by HGV's totally unsuited to the village itself. The danger of damage to parked vehicles belonging to Poltimore residents will be exacerbated and we have already experienced the centre of the village being blocked by HGV's meant for the Westexe site. Whilst this situation has, undoubtedly, improved since new signage was introduced to the private track entranceway additional traffic can only increase the likelihood of further instances. Therefore, the Council do not support this application.
