There was no mention of it in their Land Registry documentation. Whether the bowls had been sold off separately is an interesting question. It had been established that the land where the Bowls are situated was purchased by Highways England in 1981 so they could have access to the field next to the motorway. C Cllr H Gent agreed to establish this fact and try to get the process moving to restore the bowl.
