Mr Reeves who lives at Kilmore House, Poltimore gave a presentation on the development of 8 Affordable Dwellings plus 4 three and four-bedroom dwellings on land West of Kilmore.

**103/18 COUNTY ISSUES** Sent by email from C Cllr R Bloxham update on the last report.

The process of looking at Speed has commenced. There will be a series of meetings looking at speed limit policy, urban roads, 20 mph zones and speed around schools among other issues. I anticipate a report in the autumn. Both Cllr Randall-Johnson and I took part in the spotlight review on problem gambling. It kills about 500 young people annually through suicide – can start very young with children gambling dinner money and getting hooked. Whilst many people gamble without any issues, It is an addiction in some and that is the area we are looking at. There is a significant disparity between the control of gambling on premises (betting shops, casinos, pubs and holiday parks to name a few) and gambling on line. We expect a report at the Corporate Scrutiny meeting in September.
